## Insight Grant Bootcamp: Module Overview

### **IG Summary**

- 1 Page text box (3800 characters)
- Often used as a "primer" document in SSHRC committee discussion
- VERY important in capturing attention and inciting interest in reviewers

## Insight Grant Bootcamp: Module Overview

### **IG Summary Tips**

- Use clear, plain language avoid jargon
- A summary of your WHOLE proposal not just the detailed description
  - Be sure to also summarize your training of students, knowledge mobilization plan and expected outcomes

## Insight Grant Bootcamp: Module Overview

### **Tips from Previous Committee Members:**

- "A project can take up any object or material, but it should do so in a way that is interesting and timely for the field"
- "The 1 pg summary was integral for presenting the notion of originality – a huge driver for application rankings"

## Insight Grant Bootcamp: Criteria

#### CRITERIA

Make sure that you address all the subcriteria in your application: each one will be assigned a score and this will determine if you are funded

## Insight Grant Bootcamp: Exercise 1

- Originality, significance and expected contribution to knowledge
- Potential influence and impact within and/or beyond the social sciences and humanities research community.
  - Consider: How will your field be different because of this work? What will be different in the world because you did this project? (both ambitious and realistic)

- Appropriateness of the theoretical approach or framework
- Appropriateness of methods/approach
  - Consider: why is the theory you employ/the method you employ the best way to answer your question and meet your objectives?

### Insight Grant Bootcamp: Exercise 2

#### **Building from Successful Summaries**

- A "snappy sentence" that draws your reviewer in
- A clear/concise statement of the challenge your project seeks to address
- A description of the potential influence and impact of the project results

## Insight Grant Bootcamp: Writing Time or Discussion Forum

#### Reminder of claims to make in your Summary:

- The objectives of the research are sound (WHY)
- The research will fill an important research gap (WHAT)
- 3. The approach, theory and methods, as well as the research outputs, fit together and are original (HOW)
- 4. The researchers and collaborators are well suited to conduct the research and conduct to the development of talent and new knowledge (WHO)
